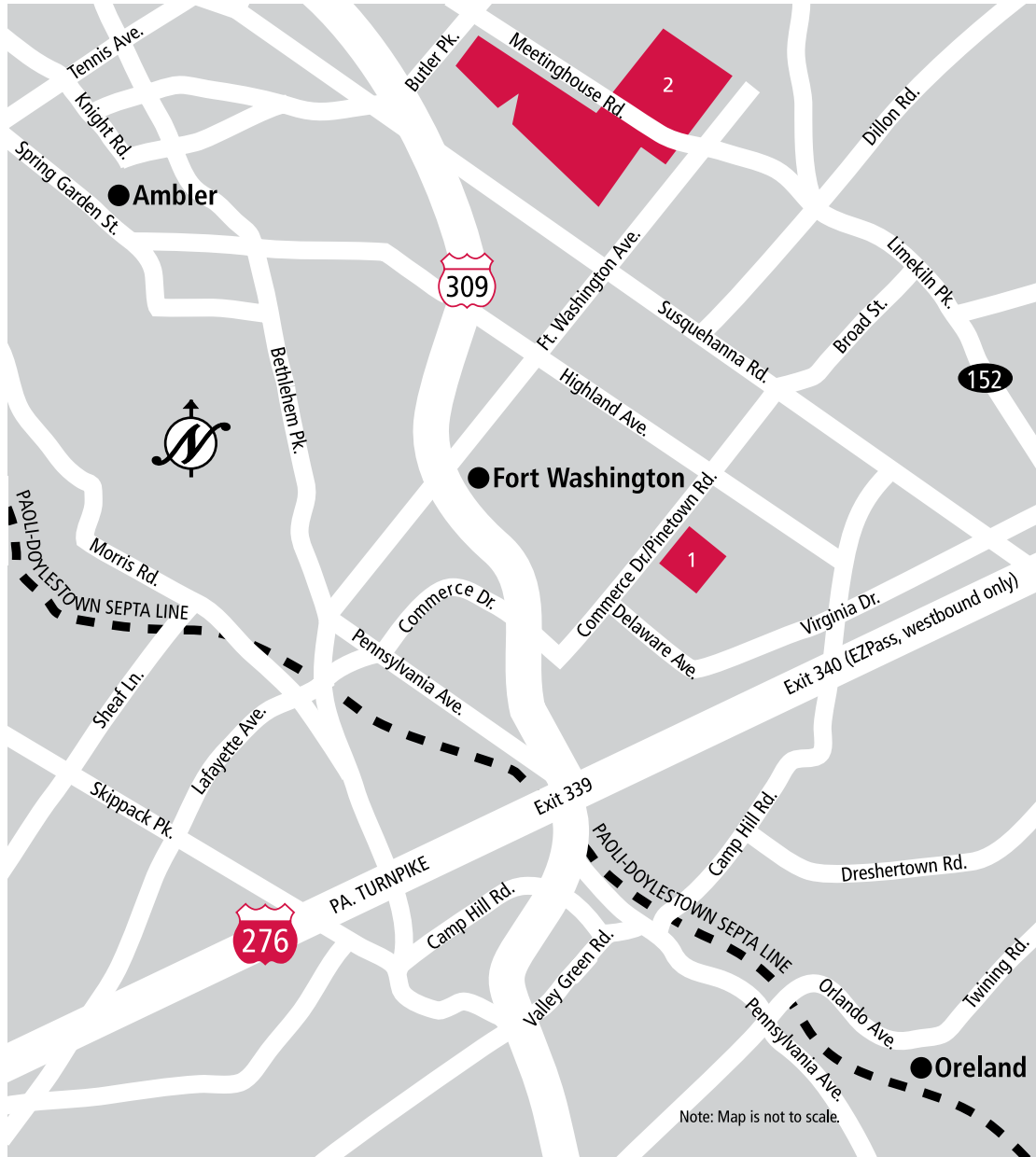

# About the University

With nearly 40,000 students and 17 schools and colleges, Temple University is a world-class comprehensive research and teaching university. Located midway between New York City and Washington, D.C., Temple offers a broad range of academic programs that attracts students from every state in the United States and from more than 130 foreign nations.

The university has more than 3,200 full-time and part-time faculty members, many with national and international reputations. It is one of the top 100 institutions doing research for the federal government and has one of only three university-based national survey research facilities in the nation.

Temple offers bachelor's degrees in more than 130 fields, master's degrees in 121 and doctoral degrees in 56. The university also offers programs in seven first professional degree areas.

A member of the Pennsylvania Commonwealth System of Higher Education, Temple University is governed by a 36-member Board of Trustees. ## To Temple University Fort Washington

### From points north (Montgomeryville):

Take Route 309 South. Take the Fort Washington/Oreland exit towards Fort Washington. Merge onto Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the first light (Commerce Drive). Proceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the first light at Delaware Avenue. Continue past the light and turn right at the second driveway to arrive at Temple University Fort Washington, 425 Commerce Drive.

### From Broad Street and points south (Cheltenham):

Take Route 309 North. Follow the signs for Fort Washington and take the Fort Washington/Pennsylvania Turnpike exit towards Fort Washington (the second right on the exit ramp). Proceed on the exit road, which becomes Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the second light (Commerce Drive). Proceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the first light at Delaware Avenue. Continue past the light and turn right at the second driveway to arrive at Temple University Fort Washington, 425 Commerce Drive.

### From the Pennsylvania Turnpike:

Take Fort Washington Exit 339\*. Proceed straight ahead on the exit road, which becomes Pennsylvania Avenue. Make a right at the second light (Commerce Drive). Proceed  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the first light at Delaware Avenue. Continue past the light and turn right at the second driveway to arrive at Temple University Fort Washington, 425 Commerce Drive.

\*Exit 340 (Virginia Dr.) is ONLY available for EZPass ticket holders who are traveling westbound. See map.

### From Temple University Ambler:

Turn right from the Visitors Parking Lot (Lot #1) onto Meetinghouse Road. Proceed to Fort Washington Avenue (the first light) and make a right. Travel approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the first traffic light at Susquehanna Road. Turn left and go approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the first traffic light at Pinetown Road. Turn right onto Pinetown Road (Pinetown changes into Commerce Drive) and travel about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile. Temple University Fort Washington is on the left at 425 Commerce Drive. Turn left into the driveway.

### Parking:

Parking is available in the lot adjacent to the 425 building.

## Temple University Fort Washington

The Temple University Fort Washington Graduate and Professional Education Center offers graduate programs and non-credit courses for adult learners. More than 400 graduate students attend evening and weekend classes. The Center features corporate style classrooms equipped with smart technology, a 30-seat computer classroom, and video-conference rooms.
