- WHO:** For a select group of young instrumentalists from Philadelphia schools who might not otherwise have access to individual instruction, the program provides high-quality lessons at an affordable cost. Piano, guitar, and voice instruction are **not** offered.
- WHAT:** Each student is responsible for \$240 of the total tuition fee for individual lessons (approximately \$8 per lesson-payable in 4 installments). Additional financial assistance is available. There is no charge for participation in music theory class. There is an additional \$40 charge (for the year) for participation in String Orchestra, Jazz Ensemble, Brass & Wind Ensemble and Chamber Winds.
